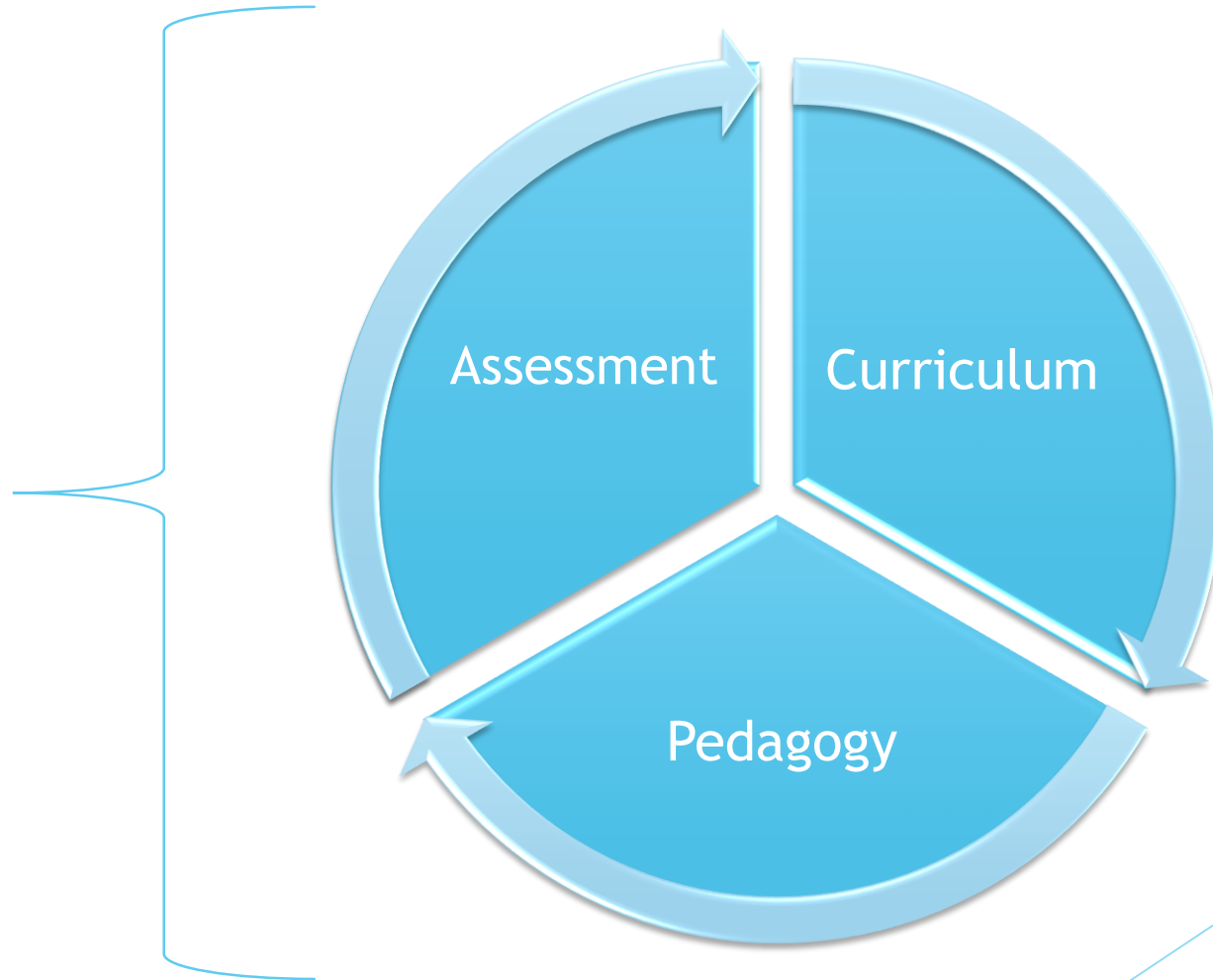

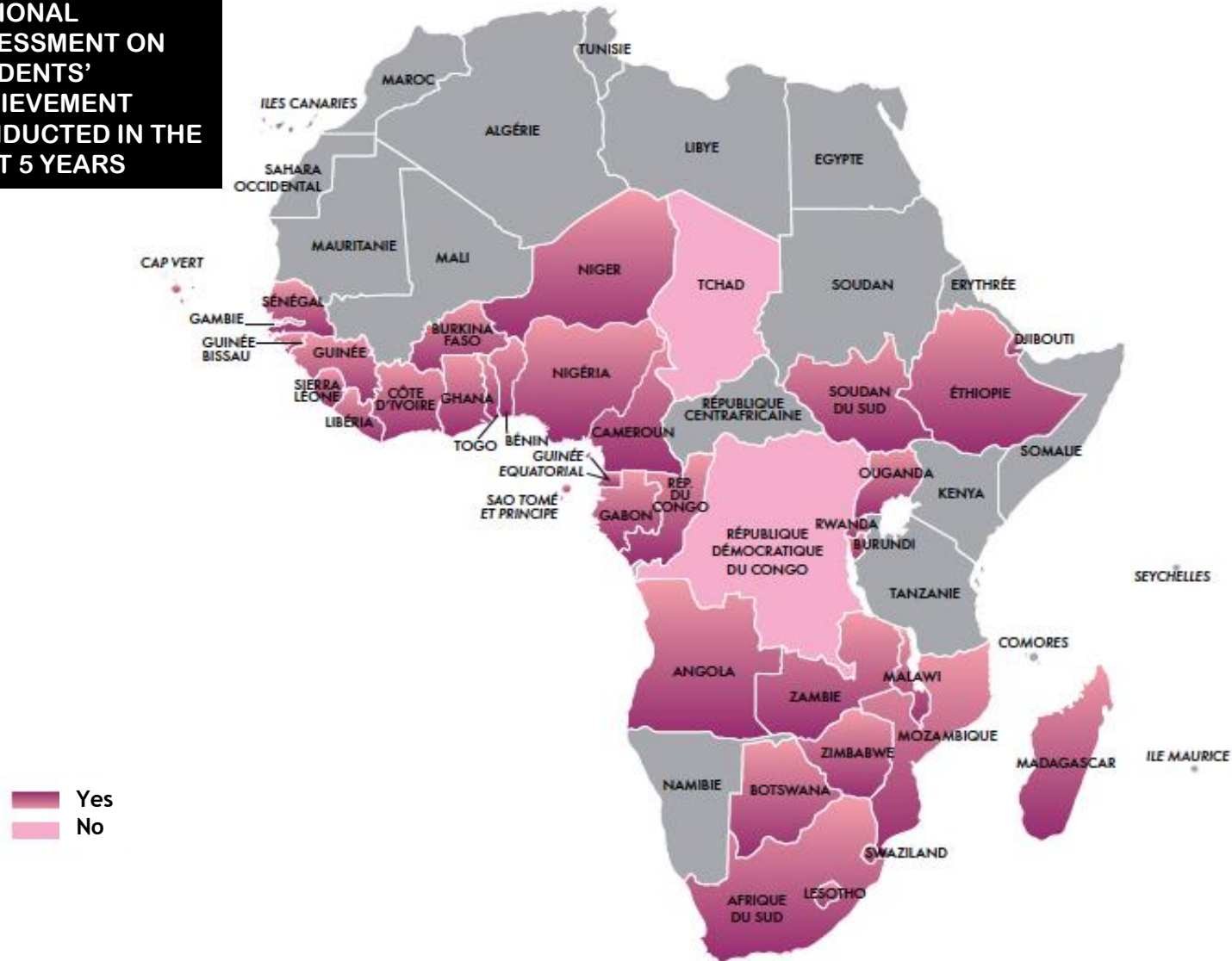
Learning assessment systems' map

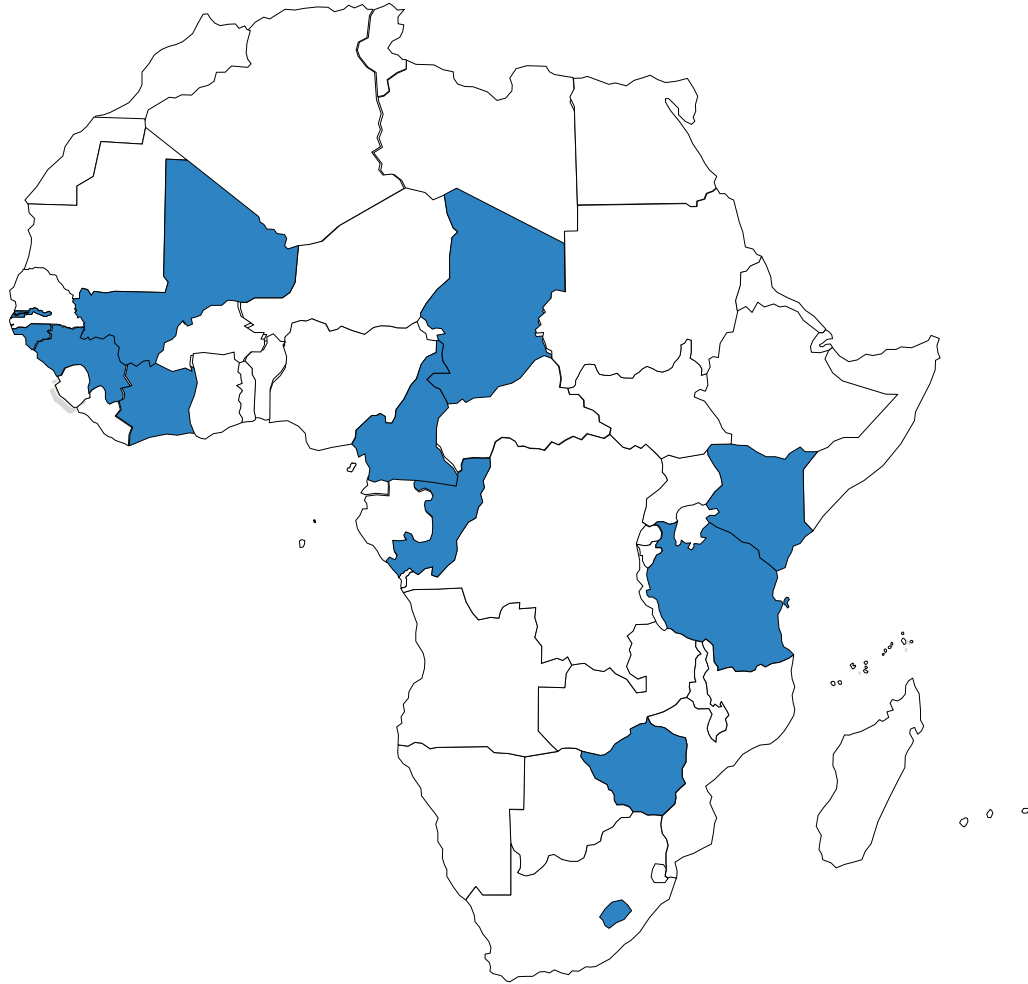
